Reading and Public Hearing

The Texas Election Code requires the local governing body to canvass the election results not earlier than the third day or later than the eleventh day after the election day.

In accordance with the contract agreement with Tarrant County, the Tarrant County Elections Administration tabulates the results and provides cumulative and precinct by percent reports following the May 6, 2023 election. The Ballot Board will meet Monday, May 16, 2023 to review the provisional and overseas ballots, and Tarrant County will provide the official election results for the resolution canvassing the City of Colleyville Special Election.

A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE MAY 6, 2023 SPECIAL ELECTION TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE VOTERS DESIRE TO CONTINUE THE COLLEYVILLE CRIME CONTROL AND PREVENTION DISTRICT AND THE ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (0.5%) SALES AND USE TAX FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF 20 YEARS
