Explanation

Reading and Public Hearing

The Texas Election Code requires the local governing body to canvass the election results not earlier than the third day or later than the eleventh day after the election day.

In accordance with the contract agreement with Tarrant County, the Tarrant County Elections Administration tabulates the results and provides cumulative and precinct by percent reports following the May 4, 2024 election. The Ballot Board met on Friday, May 10, 2024 to review the provisional and overseas ballots, and Tarrant County will provide the official election results on the resolution canvassing the election.

Certificates of election will be issued to the Councilmembers for Place 5 and Place 6. The newly elected Councilmembers will take the oath of office at the regular City Council Meeting on May 21, 2024.
