1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Jerome Davis called the meeting of the Colleyville Public Library to order at 6:10 p.m.

Roll Call: Present Chairperson Jerome Davis, Board members Billie Tuttle, Thad Bolline, Kay Newton, Charna Logan-Gray; Library, Parks and Recreation Director Mary Rodne, Assistant City Manager/Chief Financial Officer Terry Leake, Administrative Assistants Kathy Moore and Kristi Isbell

Absent Board members Victoria Kennedy-Ziegler, Melissa Orlando and Pam Jones; Ex-Officio member Cecilia Monacelli

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

June 10, 2013

A motion was made by Thad Bolline and seconded by Kay Newton to approve the June 10, 2013 minutes as presented. **Motion approved unanimously.**

3. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

3a Library Board appointment updates

Library Director Mary Rodne reminded the Board members with expiring terms that appointment applications were due to the City Secretary's office by August 30 for those who wanted to reapply for the Colleyville Library Board. It was noted that there were five (5) positions on the Library Board whose terms were expiring in September 2013.

3b City of Colleyville Fiscal Year 2014 (FY 2014) budget update

Director Rodne presented an update on the proposed Colleyville Public Library FY2014 budget and noted that the City Council would be adopting the FY2014 budget at the September 17, 2013 City Council meeting. She noted that the Library's budget was basically the same as last year and that the budget have been incorporated as submitted.

There was extended discussion concerning the budgetary needs within the Library; Assistant City Manager/Chief Financial Officer Terry Leake gave an overview of the FY2014 budget process focusing on the Library's operating budget, the general fund and the salary compensation update.

3c Approval of the use of the Voluntary Library Fund for the purchase of library materials, materials processing supplies, and library programs

Library Director Rodne presented an overview of the Voluntary Library Fund report, which gave projections through July 2013. Rodne stated that the anticipated available funds were \$155,000, and requested \$145,000 be used for the purchase of library materials, materials processing supplies and programs. The Board discussed the proposed expenditures of \$145,000 for the purchase of collection materials, materials processing supplies and library programs. A motion was made by Billie Tuttle and seconded by Charna Gray to make a recommendation to City Council to proceed with the expenditure of these funds for the purchase of library materials, materials processing supplies and library programs, in an amount not to exceed \$145,000 for the FY2014 budget year. **Motion approved unanimously.**

3d Discussion of Library meeting room policy

Director Rodne explained to the Board the need to update the Colleyville Public Library meeting room space policy to reflect changes due to the Second Floor Expansion project. Rodne noted that as a result of the high internal usage for Library programming and City uses, the current policy no longer supported the needs of the Library.

Rodne informed the Board members that the update would include new verbiage for the Statement of Purpose to read: that the policy is to support the goals and missions of the Colleyville Public Library. In addition, she noted that item 4 – *Colleyville non-profit organizations engaged in educational, cultural, intellectual, civic, or charitable activities* would be deleted along with all the general information pertaining to space rentals. In closing, Rodne stated that the Colleyville Center is the designated rental facility and is designed to provide for the meeting room rental needs within the community.

Director Mary Rodne concluded that she would update the policy and bring it forward for approval at a future meeting.

3e Discussion of the Colleyville Public Library tenth anniversary year events

Director Rodne stated that the Summer Reading Program kicked off the ten year celebration with larger events which included the opening and the finale. It was noted that both were family focused and included activities for children. Rodne noted that the November event would include a program to celebrate accomplishments

and thank the groups and individuals who have supported the Library over the last ten years.

Discussion ensued with the exchange of several thoughts and ideas. It was agreed that the planning Committee would meet with staff and start formulating plans for the event.

3f Suggested items for future meetings

No items were brought forward for future agendas.

4. REPORTS

4a Librarian's Report

Monthly Statistics

Library Director Rodne distributed Colleyville Public Library Usage Statistics, for review and discussion. In June and July, patrons had checked out a total of 63,132 items, 392 patrons had registered for library cards, library patron visits totaled 27,277, attendance for programs totaled 7,535 and volunteer hours totaled 1,649 hours. Rodne noted that the total circulation of library materials this year was 3% higher than the total circulation of library materials last year at this time. Additionally, Rodne noted that virtual visits, tracked through the Library's downloadable collection websites, were now being included in the Library's patron visit statistics.

Donations

Director Rodne reported that the Library had received a total of \$500 in donations in June and July. In June, there were no donations. In July, donations included \$500 from the Friends of the Colleyville Public Library for the purchase of summer reading grand prizes.

Library Programs

Director Rodne reported that the Summer Reading Program, *Have Book Will Travel*, had ended on July 27 and that the Summer Reading Program Finale was held on August 2. Around 850 had attended the finale program, which featured inflatable rides, games, crafts, balloon art, and face painting, etc. A total of 1,305 participants included 1,182 children, 82 adults, and 41 teens in the Summer Reading Program. Around 9,640 had attended 144 library sponsored programs, which was highest number of programs presented to date. Additionally, Rodne noted that the Chess Club had been a very popular program again this summer and that a Northeast Tarrant Libraries Chess Club Tournament was scheduled to be held at the Colleyville Public Library on August 17, 2013. Rodne concluded that overall the Summer Reading Program had once again been very successful and that statistics in several areas had

reached record-breaking numbers. The Board reviewed the statistics and discussed the outstanding community response to the program.

Rodne concluded that the Library's fall program brochure was now available online.

4b Friends of the Colleyville Public Library Report

President Kay Newton reported that the Friends of the Colleyville Public Library had held an annual meeting in June. Newton announced that during the meeting, Executive Board officers for FY 2013-2014 had been elected and included: President, Kay Newton; Vice-President, Nancy Tuuling; Secretary, Billie Tuttle; and Treasurer, Vicki Smith. Additionally, Newton noted that the Friends had voted to donate \$500 for Summer Reading Program grand prizes and that the meeting program featured an interactive program on how to use the Library's free digital content: eBooks, eMagazines, and more. Newton concluded that the Friends plan to sponsor more hands-on programs in the future to promote the usage of the Library's digital material collection.

4c Colleyville Public Library Foundation Report

Mary Rodne stated that the Library Foundation had not met recently, and that a Committee was still working on the redesign of the adult reading area.

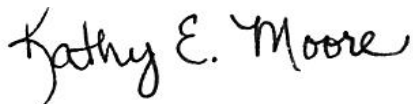

The Colleyville Library Board bylaws states that the Board shall elect a Chair and Vice-Chair from among the members annually; Officers shall serve one-year terms or until a successor is elected. The Colleyville City Council appointed new members on September 17, 2013; thereby, the election of new officers shall be held this meeting, October 14, 2013.

COLLEYVILLE LIBRARY BOARD BYLAWS

ARTICLE I – Identification and Purpose

The Colleyville Library Board was established by the City Council of Colleyville, Texas, by Ordinance O-04-1466 on June 15, 2004. The purpose of the Colleyville Library Board is to act as an advisory board to the City Council relating to all nature of library facility planning and programming.

ARTICLE II – Membership

- 2.1 The Colleyville Library Board shall consist of seven (7) members, who shall be appointed by the City Council for a two (2) year term; provided three (3) members shall be appointed each odd-numbered year and four (4) members must be appointed each even-numbered year. Places on the Board shall be numbered one (1) through seven (7). The Board shall also consist of two (2) alternates serving two-year terms. Alternates shall be numbered Alternate 1 and Alternate 2.
- 2.2 Members shall serve without compensation and until their successors are appointed.
- 2.3 Members must be residents of Colleyville, Texas unless City Council waives the residency requirement.
- 2.4 In the event of a vacancy on the Colleyville Library Board, Alternate 1 shall fill the unexpired term and Alternate 2 shall be appointed to serve as Alternate 1. In the event of more than one vacancy on the Board, Alternate 1 and Alternate 2 shall fill the unexpired terms. Applications shall be accepted through the City Secretary's office for the Alternate position(s) and filled by City Council appointment for the length of the unexpired term.
- 2.5 The City Council, if it deems it desirable, may appoint ex-officio members to the Board. Such ex-officio members shall be appointed on an annual basis and the term of office of such ex-officio members shall be one year from the date of appointment. Such ex-officio members shall have no voting authority. In consideration of appointment of ex-officio members to the Board, the President of the Friends of the Colleyville Public Library and the President of the Colleyville Public Library Foundation shall be appointed to serve as ex-officio members with concurrent terms of the Presidents of the Friends of the Colleyville Public Library and the Colleyville Public Library Foundation.

- 2.6 If a member of the Colleyville Library Board fails to maintain a seventy-five percent (75%) attendance record for all regularly scheduled meetings, the Chair or staff liaison will notify the City Secretary. City Council may, at its discretion, declare a vacancy, advertise the open position, or appoint a replacement without advertising.

ARTICLE III – Officers

- 3.1 The officers of the Colleyville Library Board shall be the Chair and the Vice Chair.
- 3.2 The Colleyville Library Board shall elect the Chair and Vice Chair from among the members annually. The officers shall serve one-year terms or until a successor is elected.
- 3.3 In the event of resignation or incapacity of the Chair, the Vice Chair shall serve as the Chair for the unexpired portion of the term.
- 3.4 City staff shall take minutes of the meeting and serve as custodian of Colleyville Library Board records.

ARTICLE IV – Meetings

- 4.1 Regular meetings shall be held bi-monthly on the second Monday of the month at 6:00 p.m. at the Colleyville Public Library, located at 110 Main Street. Meeting dates, times and location may be changed as necessary.
- 4.2 Members unable to attend a regular meeting shall notify the Chair or staff liaison by noon of the meeting day.
- 4.3 A majority of the voting Colleyville Library Board members shall constitute a quorum to conduct business of the Library Board. The act of the Colleyville Library Board members, present at a meeting, at which a quorum is in attendance, shall constitute the act of the Colleyville Library Board.
- 4.4 Meeting agendas will be posted on the City Hall bulletin boards and the City's web site 72 hours prior to a meeting. Meeting agenda packets will be available to the public on the City's website 72 hours prior to a meeting. Approved meeting minutes will be included in City Council agenda packets under Reports.
- 4.5 Meeting agenda packets will be distributed to each member 72 hours prior to a meeting.
- 4.6 The Chair shall preside at all meetings. In the absence of the Chair, the Vice Chair shall preside.
- 4.7 The Chair may recognize individuals wishing to speak regarding an item on the agenda.

- 4.8 Special meetings may be called at the request of the Chair or three members of the Colleyville Library Board for the transaction of business. Posting and notification meeting requirements shall apply to special meetings.
- 4.9 The Colleyville Library Board may establish sub committees as deemed appropriate. Such committees will be dissolved upon completion of the charge or task.

ARTICLE V – Duties and Responsibilities

- 5.1 The Colleyville Library Board acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council in all matters pertaining to the library facility planning and programming, including development of long range capital improvement programs.
- 5.2 Recommend policies for library services, and the adoption of standards for public library facilities and their financial support.
- 5.3 Receives requests for public funding for educational purposes of any public or private person(s), associations or business entities, and forward such requests with recommendations to City Council.
- 5.4 Review the annual operating budget and capital improvement requests related to library programs with the Library Director, and provide recommendations to the Director for submission to the City Manager or designee for consideration.
- 5.5 Cooperate with City boards, commissions, and committees, other governmental agencies, civic groups, and all citizens of the City in the advancement of sound library planning and programming.
- 5.6 Board members will take the Attorney General Texas Open Meetings Act on-line training course, available on this link.
http://www.oag.state.tx.us/open/og_training.shtml#22, or you may obtain a DVD of the training course from the City Secretary, and provide a copy of the Certificate of Course Completion to the City Secretary. The training must be completed not later than the 90th day after the date the member takes the oath of office or otherwise assumes responsibilities as a member of the governmental body.

ARTICLE VI – Amendments

- 6.1 These bylaws may be amended by a majority vote at any regular meeting, if all members have been notified of the proposed amendment 72 hours prior to such meeting. Amendments must be in compliance with applicable City ordinances.
