1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Vernon Noronha called the meeting of the Colleyville Public Library to order at 6:07 p.m.

ROLL CALL

Present Board members: Chairperson Vernon Noronha, Kay Newton, Nancy Andrews, Molly Skinner, Billie Tuttle, Seanna Billinger, Library and Recreation Director Mary Rodne, Administrative Assistant Kristi Isbell

Absent Alternate Board Members Shanti Kannan and Joan Roberts; Ex Officios Nancy Tuuling and Cecilia Monacelli

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

April 18, 2016

A motion was made by Kay Newton and seconded by Billie Tuttle to approve the April 18, 2016 minutes with one correction. Ex Officio Nancy Tuuling was listed as both present and absent. The minutes should reflect that Ex Officio Nancy Tuuling was absent for the April 18 meeting. The motion was approved unanimously. Director Mary Rodne explained that Vice-Chair Victoria Kennedy-Ziegler had resigned from the Library Board due to their relocation out of state.

3. REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS

3a Overview of the 2016 Summer Reading Program

Director Mary Rodne stated that registration for the Summer Reading Program was higher than in previous years. Rodne explained that the staff made presentations to all grades at Bransford Elementary and O.C. Taylor Elementary; grades K-4 at Colleyville Elementary; grades K-3 at Glen Hope Elementary; and, a preschool class at Compass Christian Preschool. Rodne added that NRH20 Family Water Park donated 500 tickets to the Summer Reading Program and that these tickets were used as early registration incentives. Rodne stated that the number of registrations reached 500 in the first three days of registration. Rodne described the circus-themed Kick-Off Party

and stated that 650 attended this event. Rodne stated, thus far in the program, there were 1,077 children, teens, and adults registered.

Rodne provided an update on the story time registrations and explained that each class had a wait list and that we were able to open a second session of one of the afternoon classes due to high demand. Rodne gave highlights of upcoming events including the Tuesday/Thursday performers, Movie Days, Legomania, Chess Club, and the Grand Finale scheduled for July 29, 2016. Chair Vernon Noronha added that he checked the program offerings at five area libraries and the Colleyville Library offered significantly more summer programs.

3b Update on the Colleyville Public Library Long-Range Plan

Director Rodne provided an overview of the Long-Range Plan and noted that the next phase would be to create a document that would detail the implementation plan recommendations.

3c Discussion of Items for Future Agendas

The next regularly scheduled meeting was tentatively set for Monday, August 8, 2016.

4. REPORTS

4a Librarian's Report

A. Monthly Statistics:

Director Rodne provided an overview of the statistics for the months of April and May 2016.

B. Donations:

Rodne stated that the Library received a total of \$6,060.04. In April, the Library received \$36.29 from Robert Jackson as a donation of the overage on his utility bill to the library when closing his account; and, \$23.75 from Sharon Walker for the purchase of a children's book in honor of her mother's birthday. In May, the Library received \$6,000.00 from the Colleyville Woman's Club for the purchase of digital audiobooks.

C. Library Programs:

Rodne stated that staff would begin planning the fall programs in July in order to prepare the digital brochure for distribution by September.

4b Friends of the Colleyville Public Library Report

Kay Newton reported that the Friends recently held their annual election of officers: Joan Roberts was elected President, Mary Alice Rippe was elected Vice-President, Kay Newton was elected Treasurer, Nancy Tuuling was elected Secretary. Newton stated

that the Friends of the Colleyville Public Library had been selected to be the non-profit beneficiary, of Whole Foods Colleyville, for the current quarter. Newton stated, as a result, Friends representatives worked a promotional display, at Whole Foods, on Wednesday, June 8, 2016 and were told that they would receive approximately \$1,700.00 as a percentage of sales from that day.

4c Colleyville Public Library Foundation Report

Director Rodne reported on behalf of the Library Foundation and stated that the Foundation had met on April 18, 2016 and was scheduled to meet again on June 20, 2016. Rodne stated that the Foundation has reorganized with the goal of fundraising in the fall.

5. CITIZEN COMMENTS/PRESENTATIONS REGARDING ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

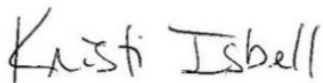

Approval of the use of the Voluntary Library Fund for purchase of library materials, materials processing supplies, and library programs.

Explanation

Resolution R-03-2237 provides for the Voluntary Library Fund to be used for the purpose of the development and improvement of library programs and services and for approved library programs and capital items, including collection development (books and other materials). In October 2006, City Council approved Resolution R-06-2768, which increased the monthly Voluntary Library Fund contribution amount from \$1.00 to \$2.00 per month. As of July 31, 2016, the projected available Voluntary Library Fund balance is \$314,798. It is projected that the actual fund balance will be higher as FY 2016 total expenditures are not anticipated to be \$107,421. It has been determined that funds are available in the Voluntary Library Fund.

This item provides for the Colleyville Public Library Board to make a recommendation to the City Council for use of the Voluntary Library Fund, for the purchase of library collection materials, collection processing supplies and library programs in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the best interest of the citizens of Colleyville will be served by providing for a voluntary library fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has established the Colleyville Public Library Board and this Board shall serve as a recommending body to the City Council for the use of the Voluntary Library Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEYVILLE, TEXAS:

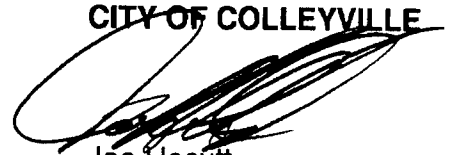
- Sec. 1. THAT a voluntary library fund has been established for the purpose of the development and improvement of library programs and services; and said fund can be used for approved library programs and capital items, including collection development (books and materials) and other items as desired by the City Council; however, said fund will not be used to provide for ongoing library maintenance and operations.
- Sec. 2. THAT the voluntary library fund is funded through a voluntary donation of one (\$1) per month from the citizens of Colleyville.
- Sec. 3. THAT this fee is listed with the Library Donation Fund as a separate entry on the Colleyville residents' water bills and is in all ways strictly voluntary.

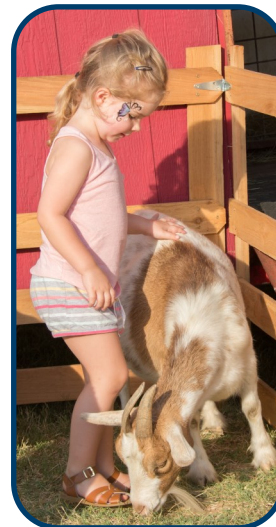
