RESOLUTION R-21-4590

A RESOLUTION CONTINUING THE EMERGENCY DECLARATION OF DISASTER ISSUED BY MAYOR RICHARD NEWTON ON FEBRUARY 18, 2021

- WHEREAS,** the City of Colleyville has suffered probable injuries to City roads, public facilities, and other public infrastructure as a result of the winter storm that began on February 12, 2021, creating an imminent threat to public health and safety; and
- WHEREAS,** the County Judge of Tarrant County declared a state of disaster in Tarrant County on February 15, 2021; and
- WHEREAS,** the Governor of Texas declared a state of disaster in all 254 counties in Texas; and
- WHEREAS,** on February 18, 2021, the Mayor declared a local state of disaster by proclamation for the City of Colleyville, pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code and Section 3.06 of the City Charter (the "Declaration"); and
- WHEREAS,** state law provides that the Mayor's Declaration shall continue for a period of not more than seven (7) days from the date of issuance, unless the same is continued by the City Council of the City of Colleyville, Texas, pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEYVILLE, TEXAS:

- Sec. 1. THAT the City Council has determined that extraordinary measures, including continuance of the Declaration, must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare.
- Sec. 2. THAT, pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the City Council hereby extends the Declaration for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date of this resolution.
- Sec. 3. THAT the Mayor is authorized to amend, modify, or terminate the Declaration by further proclamation during the above-referenced period of time in conformance with Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code and Section 3.06 of the City Charter.

Sec. 4. THAT this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
